- All athletes on a team must attend the same BC elementary school
- Overage athletes currently in Grade 7 will be allowed to compete for their school.

BC Athletics Membership Requirements:

- All participants in all age groups in ***The 2012 Vancouver Sun Harry Jerome Indoor Track Classic*** must be 2012 Competitive Athlete Members of BC Athletics or another Provincial/Territorial or foreign Athletics Assoc; or
- Elementary through Secondary School athletes competing for their school and who are not BC Athletics Competitive Athlete members can take out a \$3.00 School Day of Event Membership per athlete which is in addition to the entry fee or:

- Elementary thru High Schools that have a **2011/2012 BC Athletics School Club or School District Club Membership** who are not required to pay the School Day of Event Membership.

School Team Registration & Spectators:

- Team and spectator access to the Track Zone starts at 8:30 am.
- Coaches can pick up Team packages at the **School Teams** table at the main entrance lobby in the Oval. Each team registration includes one complimentary adult pass.
- The four runners plus adult in charge must check in at the same time.
- Spectators: This year, there is no charge for spectators for the Jerome Outreach Relays!
- General Admission tickets (\$5.00) for the Youth/Open **Jerome Indoor Track Classic** that follows the relays go on sale at 10:30 am. Children under 13 accompanied by an adult are free.

Seeding and Finals:

- All races are timed finals. If two sections are required we will attempt to place teams from the same school in separate sections.

Check-in Times:

- **Teams will be marshaled no sooner than 20 minutes before the posted start time** for that race. Do not send teams earlier than this as they will be sent back to the stands. Athletes must report ready to run.
- The marshalling area is on the long straightaway along the north-side window wall of the complex

Important Notes:

- All relay team members must wear school jerseys during their races.
- **The use of track shoes containing spikes is not allowed for these events and will be rigorously enforced.**

Awards:

- Medals to top 3 finishers determined by best overall times.
- Ribbons to finishers 4th through 10th.
- Medals will be awarded and ribbons provided immediately after the last Gr 6/7 Boys race is completed (approx 10:40 am). Trophy presentations will also be made.

Parking:

- Covered pay parking (\$1.00 per hour) is available at the facility. With large groups at special events (like ours) parking becomes quite limited and car-pooling or public transit is highly recommended!
- Overflow parking at no charge has been arranged for at the WorkSafe BC (WCB) complex just one block south with entrance on Elmbridge Way just west of intersection with Hollybridge Way. There is a direct pathway between warehouses to and from the Oval.

Athletes who do not have a Individual 2012 BC Athletics competitive membership or who belong to a School or School District that does not have a 2012 School Membership are required to take out a **\$3 School Day of Event Membership** at check-in in order to participate in the meet. Such athletes may not compete in their school colours and must be registered as 'unattached'.
